

NOTE ON VISA REQUIREMENTS TO ATTEND THE LEAD AUTHOR

MEETING 3 (LAM-3) OF IPCC WG3 IN VIGO, SPAIN

This note provides with information on visa requirements for delegates attending the Lead Author Meeting-3 (LAM-3) of IPCC WG3 to be held in Vigo (Spain), 5 to 9 November 2013.

o What documentation is required to travel to Spain?

Documentation required to travel to Spain varies according to the country of origin.

According to European Community Law (EC 2414/2001, EC453/2003, EC 1932/2006 and EC1244/2009) foreigners planning to visit Spain should check the [list of countries](#) whose nationals must be in possession of visas when travelling to Spain and those whose nationals are exempted from that requirement.

The visa is requested and issued at the Spanish diplomatic missions or consular offices.

Where there is no Spanish diplomatic mission or consular office, visitor's visa can be requested from European diplomatic missions or consular offices which [represent Spain](#) in that country.

Please take into consideration possible needs for transit visas when crossing international transit zones of third countries airports outside Europe.
